Our Badger Gates have been designed to allow badgers to pass freely through fences without causing damage. Badgers often use set routes within their territory, if a stock or deer fence is put up across a badger run, they will either dig under the fence, or attempt to break through. Either way, this causes damage to the fence and may let other animals through.

- Opening is approx. 225 x 270mm

- 13 x 10mm holes at 76mm ctrs, allow easier fixing of netting and line wires.
